Motioned by Tyler Bullock seconded by Jack Powell and approved unanimously.

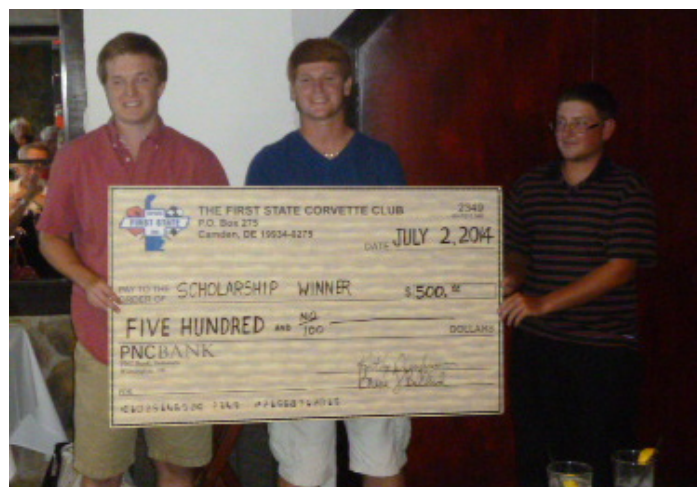
